# Ring size guide.

How to determine your ring size

#### Use your existing ring to find your size.

- 1. Print page to actual size.
- 2. Double check by measuring the actual size reference with a ruler, it should be 1 inch.
- 3. Place existing ring over each circle until there is a match. There should be a very thin black border inside the ring.
- 4. If the ring is covering the black outline completely, choose the next largest size.


### Use included ruler to find your size.

- 1. Print page to actual size.
- 2. Double check by measuring the reference area under the ruler, it should be 3.5 inches.
- 3. Cut out the ring ruler and wrap around your finger to measure. The numbers on the ruler indicate ring sizes.
